REQUEST TO PLACE A MEMORIAL MONUMENT FOR THE HELLENES ON THE GROUNDS OF THE EAST YORK CIVIC CENTRE

The Administration and Operations Committee recommends as follows:

- (1) that the Commissioner of Parks, Recreation and Operations be requested to report on the following issues in connection with the request to place a monument on the grounds of the East York Civic Centre:**
 - (i) the location of the monument;**
 - (ii) the wording for the monument;**
 - (iii) the establishment of a trust fund for ongoing maintenance of the monument;**
- (2) that the Commissioner of Parks, Recreation and Operations be requested to consult with appropriate groups such as the Royal Canadian Legion and Arts East York in formulating the aforementioned report; and**
- (3) that the following report of the Commissioner of Parks, Recreation and Operations, dated May 20, 1997, be received and noted.**

Report of the Commissioner of Parks, Recreation and Operations, dated May 20, 1997:

"Recommendation:

"That Council give staff direction on the request to place a memorial monument on the East York Civic Centre grounds to recognize all Hellenes who died in Pontos from 1916-1923.

"Background:

"On Tuesday, May 20, 1997, Mayor Prue met with Efstathios (Steve) Xanthopoulos to discuss the placement of a monument on the Civic Centre grounds. This monument would be placed in memory of all the Hellenes who died in Pontos from 1916-1923.

"Discussion:

"Mr. Xanthopoulos is planning to be present at the Administration and Operations Committee scheduled for Monday, May 26, 1997 to speak to this request.

"Financial Implications:

"It is anticipated that any costs associated with installation and respective landscaping will be borne by the organizing association.

"Communication Issues:

"There are no communication strategies anticipated at this time with this request.

"Consultation With Respective Boards and Committees:

"There are no boards or committees that have memorial monuments and placement of same within their mandate.

"Conclusion:

"Staff would request Council's guidance as per this request."

Attached to the foregoing report was a diagram depicting the statue.

Mr. Steve Xanthopoulos, 17 Delbert Drive, Scarborough, appeared before the Committee in connection with the foregoing matter.

**Conveyance of a Portion of the S. Walter Stewart
Library Lands to The City of Toronto in connection
with a request to Erect a Memorial Monument

The East York Community Council recommends that:

- (1) the following report (October 27, 1998) from the City Solicitor, East York Office, be adopted;**
- (2) the Commissioner of Economic Development, Culture and Tourism be requested to continue discussions with the Toronto Public Library Board with respect to shared parking being made available at the S. Walter Stewart Library parking lot on a permanent basis; and**
- (3) the following joint communication (November 12, 1998) from Mr. Efstathios Mihalidis, President, Brotherhood Pontion Toronto Panagia Soumela, Toronto, and Mr. Efstathios Xanthopoulos, Founder of the Monument, Toronto, be received:**

Purpose:

To authorize the acceptance of a conveyance of a portion of the Walter Stewart Library lands from the Toronto Public Library Board to the City of Toronto in order to accommodate the construction of a monument by the Pontian Brotherhood of Toronto as a memorial for the occasion of the expulsion of the Pontians from Pontus.

Funding Sources:

The Pontians have agreed to reimburse the City for the costs associated with undertaking this conveyance, and as well, they have agreed to make a lump sum contribution for the ongoing maintenance of the monument.
